- SB0908-01 (First Read) Worship and Music - Specialization in Youth Ministry:**

Specialization: Youth Ministry – 15 hrs

YOUT 201 Principles of Youth Ministry	3 hrs
YOUT 301 Foundations of Youth Ministry	3 hrs

Rationale: In an “attempt to meet [the] ever-growing market demand in youth and worship ministries, the Worship and Music Studies department has partnered with the Youth Ministry Division of the School of Religion to create...[a Worship and Music specialization in Youth Ministry]. A unique aspect of this proposal is that all classes included in the new specialization are already currently being taught within the Youth Ministry Specialization in the School of Religion. Because this specialization is already tapping into the resources of the existing Youth Ministry Division, no new faculty, no additional classroom space, no additional library holdings and no additional budgetary considerations are needed.”

- SB0908-02 (First Read) Worship and Music - Group Guitar Courses:**

- WRSP 251 Intermediate Group Guitar II - 1 Credit
Prerequisite: WRSP 250 or permission of instructor. Instruction includes technical exercises, more advanced chords and chord progressions, and further development of music reading and performance in classical, Contemporary Christian and jazz styles. Scale studies and extended chords will be stressed. Beginning improvisational techniques and chord substitutions and construction will also be explored as applied to the worship ministry. Designed to fulfill the needs for secondary instrumental requirement in guitar. Audition required. Lab fee. Offered every semester.
- WRSP 350 Advanced Group Guitar – 1 Credit
Prerequisite: WRSP 251 or permission of instructor. Group guitar lessons covering more advanced chords and chord progressions than in WRSP 251, further development of music reading and performance in classical, Contemporary Christian and jazz styles. More advanced improvisational techniques and chord substitutions and construction will also be explored. Sight reading of classical literature and contemporary lead sheets and harmonies in all styles will be stressed. Lab fee. Offered every semester.
