Professors: If you have any excellent undergraduate students who conducted high-caliber research in your LUO or residential courses this fall, please encourage them to present their findings in our university research symposium.


Students: We welcome your proposals. Instructions for submissions for 2016 will appear shortly. To get an idea though, see the instructions for 2015 at
