- **Ministry of the Father**

- A. The Father sent His Son (Jn. 3:16; 6:57; 8:16-18; 12:49; Gal. 4:4).
- B. The Father sealed His Son (Jn. 6:27).
- C. The Father taught His Son (Jn. 8:28).
- D. The Father anointed His Son (Lk. 4:18; Isa. 61:1; Acts 10:38).
- E. The Father honored His Son (Jn. 8:54).
- F. The Father commanded His Son (Jn. 10:18).
- G. The Father bore witness to His Son (Jn. 8:18).
- H. The Father loved (and loves) His Son (Jn. 10:17).
- I. The Father delighted in His Son (Isa. 42:1; Mt. 3:17; 17:5; 2 Pet. 1:17).
- J. The Father heard His Son (Mt. 26:53; Jn. 11:41, 42; 12:27, 28).
- K. The Father offered up His Son (Jn. 3:16; 18:11; Rom. 8:32; 1 Jn. 4:9, 10).
- L. The Father raised His Son (Eph. 1:20).
- M. The Father exalted His Son (Eph. 1:20; Phil. 2:9-11).
- N. The Father glorified His Son (Jn. 12:28; 17:1).
- O. The Father has made His Son Head of the Church (Eph. 1:22).
- P. The Father has committed judgment to His Son (Jn. 5:22, 27).

- **Ministry of the Holy Spirit**

- A. He was begotten by the Holy Spirit (Lk. 1:35).
- B. He was anointed by the Holy Spirit (Mt. 3:16; Heb. 1:9).
- C. He preached in the power of the Holy Spirit (Lk. 4:18).
- D. He was sealed by the Holy Spirit (Jn. 6:27).
- E. He was led by the Holy Spirit (Mt. 4:1).
- F. He worked miracles through the Holy Spirit (Mt. 12:28; Acts 10:38).
- G. He was filled by the Holy Spirit (Jn. 3:34; Lk. 4:1).
- H. He sorrowed in the Holy Spirit (Jn. 11:33).
- I. He rejoiced in the Holy Spirit (Lk. 10:21).
- J. He offered up Himself through the Holy Spirit (Heb. 9:14).
- K. He was raised from the dead by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 1:4; 1 Pet. 3:18).
- L. He commanded His apostles through the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:2).
