# Why the Child of God Should Study the Word of God

#### I. Because of its Author

God is not only a Creator, a Redeemer, a loving Father, etc. He is also an accomplished Writer. His masterpiece—The Bible! *Note:* The best thing you could say to an author is: "Yes, I have read your book."

- **II.** Because of the often-repeated commands to read it (Josh. 1:8; 2 Tim. 2:15; Mt. 4:4)
- III. Because the Bible is God's chosen way to accomplish His divine will
  - A. Sinners are saved through the message of the Bible (Rom. 10:13-17; Acts 2:14, 2:37, 8:4-8; 1 Pet. 1:23; Jas. 1:18).
  - B. Saints are sanctified; that is, to grow in grace through the message of the Bible (Jn. 17:17; 1 Pet. 2:2; 1 Thess. 4:3; Ps. 119:9-11; Jn. 15:7; Acts 20:32).
- IV. Because our enemy the devil has read it (Mt. 4:5, 6)
- V. Because of the example of Paul, possibly the greatest Christian of all time (2 Tim. 4:6-8, 13)
- VI. Because the Bible alone answers humanity's three greatest questions. These questions, pondered by every generation, are:
  - A. Where did I come from? (Gen. 1:26, 27; Ps. 100:3)
  - B. Why am I here? (Eccles. 12:13; Rev. 4:11)
  - C. Where am I going? (Jn. 3:16-18; Ps. 23:1, 6; Rev. 20:15)
- VII. Because we'll never have the opportunity to apply many of its verses after we leave this earth
  - A. There will be no opportunity to apply 1 Cor. 10:13 in heaven.
  - B. There will be no opportunity to apply 1 John 1:9 in heaven.
  - C. There will be no opportunity to apply Philippians 4:19 in heaven.
  - D. There will be no opportunity to apply John 14:1-3 in heaven.
  - E. There will be no opportunity to apply Psalm 23:4 in heaven. *Note:* And the reason? Well, in heaven there will be no temptation, nor sin, nor need, nor death.
- VIII. Because the only ultimate proof for our faith is the Bible (Jn. 20:31)
