God-Ordained Leaders—Biblical Authors

Who wrote the Bible? God wrote the Bible (2 Tim. 3:16). Man wrote the Bible (2 Pet. 1:20-21). It was a joint effort! The individuals below are leaders in God's economy. What revelations they received from God were recorded for posterity.

Moses	Wrote book of Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Psalm 90
Joshua	Wrote book of Joshua
Job	Job may have written his own story. The man, his place and his story is shrouded in mystery.
Samuel	Samuel may have written Judges, Ruth and 1 Samuel.
David	Wrote 73 and possibly 75 of the Psalms.
Sons of Korah	Wrote Psalms 42, 44-49, 84-85, 87
Asaph	Wrote Psalms 50, 73-83 A Levite and one of the leaders of David's choir
Heman	Wrote Psalm 88
Ethan	Wrote Psalm 89
Hezekiah	Wrote Psalms 120-123, 128-139, 132, 134-136 King Hezekiah was a reformer and good king of Judah.
Solomon	Wrote Psalms 72, 127, Proverbs 1-29, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon
Agur	Wrote Proverbs 30
Lemuel	Wrote Proverbs 31
Jeremiah	He wrote the book of Jeremiah, probably Lamentations, and possibly 1 and 2 Kings.
Ezra	Wrote book of Ezra and possibly 1 and 2 Chronicles and 2 Samuel
Mordecai	May have written book of Esther
Minor prophets	The twelve minor prophet books were written by the prophets whose names they bear.
Matthew	Wrote gospel of Matthew
Mark	Wrote gospel of Mark
Luke	Wrote book of Acts as well as Gospel of Luke
John	He wrote the Gospel of John, the epistles of 1, 2, 3 John and the book of Revelation.
Paul	He wrote books or epistles of Romans, 1-2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1-2 Thessalonians, 1-2 Timothy, Titus, and Philemon.
Apollos	May have written book of Hebrews
