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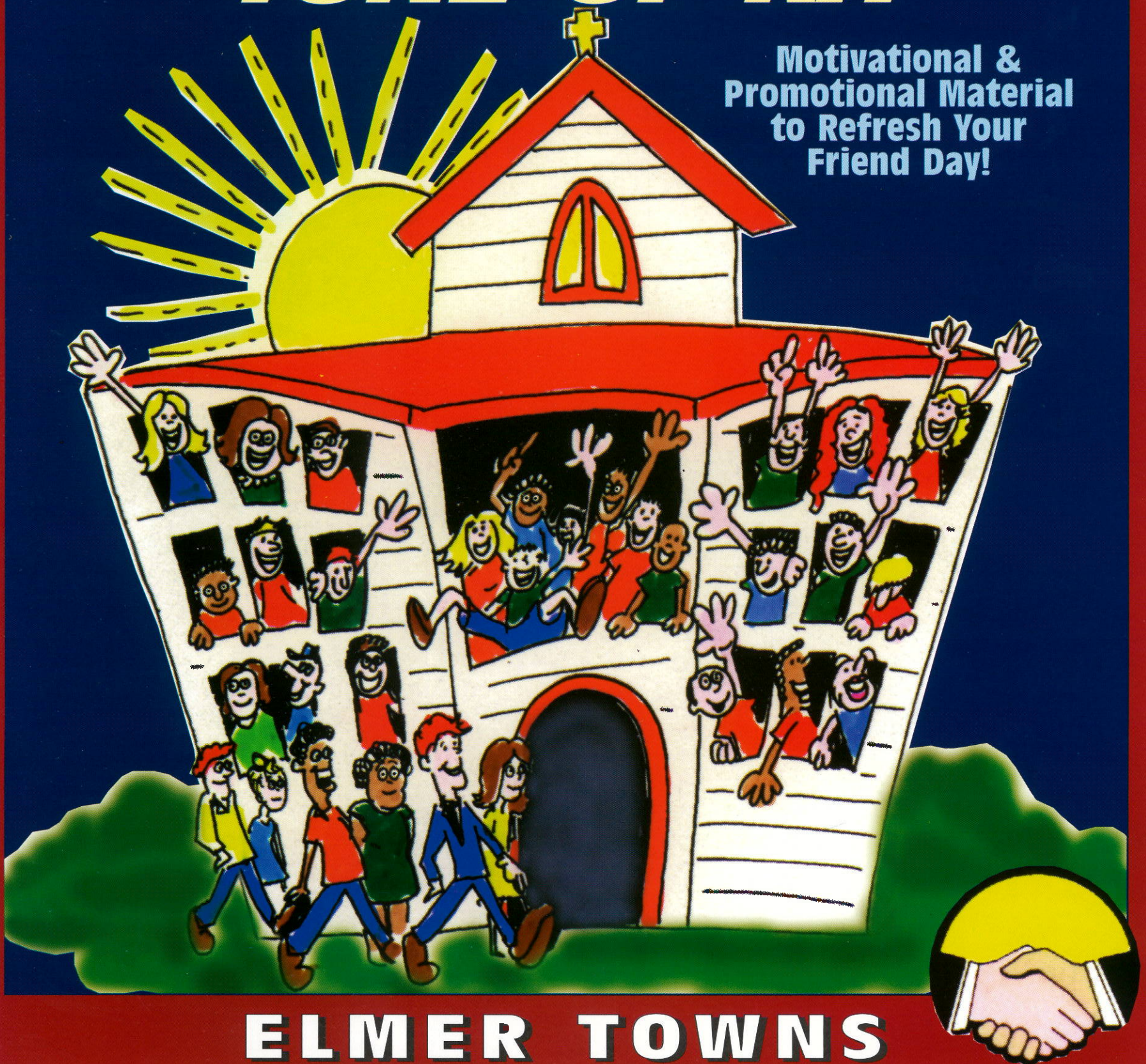

About This Resource

Most of the 30,000 plus churches who have used the original Friend Day have used it more than once. In many of those churches, Friend Day has become an annual tradition. We realized that the Friend Day faithfuls would appreciate a “face lift” of new material to refresh their ever-useful Friend Day. This *Friend Day Tune-Up Kit* was created for that purpose.

The original Friend Day lessons focus on biblical aspects of friendship and end with “How to Be a Friend of God.” The new lessons focus on spirituality—helping your members spiritually prepare for a successful Friend Day. Lesson one will guide participants in developing a vision for Friend Day. Lesson two teaches how to pray for spiritual results. Lesson three explains what fasting is and how to fast for Friend Day. Lesson four addresses the importance of faith, what it will do, ways to strengthen and express faith, and steps to faith on Friend Day. The lessons are provided in fill-in-the-blank format, followed by answer sheets. Copy the outlines to write notes on for teaching and keep the original for future use. You may choose to copy the outlines for participants so they can follow along with the teaching and have a handy reference for study and review. (For a more in-depth study of “vision” or “fasting and prayer,” see *Vision Day* and *Fasting for Spiritual Breakthrough* by Dr. Elmer Towns, available from Church Growth Institute.)

While “Friendly Freddy’s” smile has graced many a Friend Day promotional item, and will undoubtedly continue to do so, we are pleased to introduce the “Friendly Church” logo and promotional items. 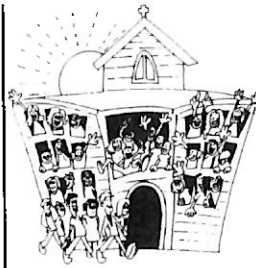

B. Praying for Spiritual Results

1. No prayer – _____. "Yet ye have not because ye ask not" (James 4:2). If you do not undergird Friend Day with prayer, you will not have great spiritual result.

"Faith if it hath not works, is dead, being alone" (James 2:17). You must invite your friends to church and pray by faith for them. "You have faith and I will work for results, but you demonstrate faith without working while I demonstrate my faith by working" (James 2:18 authors translation). This verse means those who invite

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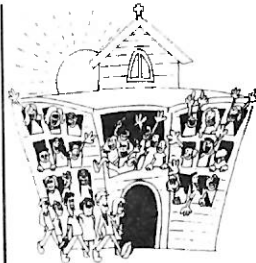

**Lesson 3: Fasting
for Spiritual Results**

A. Challenge

The methods of Friend Day will “naturally” attract many to your church. Your guests will probably not attend for spiritual reasons; they will come because of their relationship to someone in the church. Therefore, fast and pray for God to touch them spiritually.

B. What Is Fasting?

1. The first mention of fasting in the Bible: “On the tenth day of the seventh month of each year, you must go without eating to _____ for sins” (Lev. 16:29 CEV). This is called the Yom Kippur Fast (*Yom* means day, and *Kippur* is atonement). It is a one-day fast from sundown to sundown; fast the way Jews in the Bible measured a day.
2. The verb fast comes from *tsum*, i.e., _____. Fasting began with loss of appetite during times of distress and emergency. “Hannah was in great distress about her barrenness, and wept and did not eat” (1 Sam. 1:7). We fast for our friends because it is imperative (an emergency) that they become a Christian.
3. People began fasting to turn away God’s _____ (1 Kings 21:27). We fast to get our friends converted.

E. How to Fast for Friend Day

1. Fast and pray _____. Pray specifically for the friends who have signed a commitment to attend on Friend Day.
2. Fast and pray _____. Join with someone else to pray for specific individuals attending a Friend Day. “If two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them” (Matt. 18:19).
3. Fast and pray _____. Ask the Sunday School staff to join in fasting and praying for spiritual results on Friend Day. Sometimes the whole church can fast together. Begin together on Sunday evening after the evening church services. Have all workers commit themselves at the church altar to pray together.
4. Fast and pray _____. If your church is large enough, enlist one person to be responsible to fast and pray each day leading up to Friend Day. Notice the verb for fasting is continuous, “This kind cometh not out but by prayer and fasting” (Matt. 17:21).

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5. Use different _____ of fasting. There are several ways to fast. Don't force the same fast on everyone. Those who are diabetic – or have other health problems demanding food – can enter the spirit of fasting, but they will eat. Note the following:

- Fast one meal a day until Friend Day
- Fast from meat (Dan. 1:12)
- Fast from desserts (Dan. 10:3)
- Normal fast (liquids only)
- Fast pleasures (i.e., television, sports, etc.)
- Wesley fast (bread and water)
