

Schedule Library Instruction

<u>Liaison librarians</u> are available to teach information literacy skills to your students in person, online, or through <u>custom tutorials</u> and <u>Research Guides</u>. They can also provide training to faculty in your department on using library resources and tools or partner with you to incorporate information literacy into assignments. In addition to formalized library instruction, you and

your students can access live research support through <u>chat</u>, <u>email</u>, and <u>phone</u> anytime that the library is <u>open</u>. You can also <u>schedule a meeting with a research librarian</u> for extensive

questions, or stop by the research support desk at the Customer Service Center Monday-Friday between 9 a.m.-5 p.m. for walk-up assistance.



Check Your Links

Please check any links that you have to library resources in your documents, presentations, instructional materials, Canvas courses, or bookmarks. The library has transitioned from EZproxy to OpenAthens for resource authentication. While links that have EZproxy at the beginning of the web address may currently work, they will soon be non-functional.

You can explore the <u>Open Athens Research Guide</u> for instructions on creating stable permalinks for library resources that can replace your old EZproxy links. If you have any questions about obtaining permalinks,

please contact your <u>liaison librarian</u> for assistance. Additionally, you can <u>watch this brief</u> <u>tutorial</u> that demonstrates how to convert EZproxy links to OpenAthens links.

Visit the Library's Family-Friendly Space

The <u>Curriculum Library</u> is a cozy, family-friendly section of the library that houses children's and young adult literature, secular and Christian PreK-grade 12 teacher edition textbooks, teaching materials and supplies, English as a Second Language (ESL) materials, educational manipulatives and models, a Cricut machine, die-cut shapes and letters, a button maker, and more. You can also have materials laminated or spiral bound and purchase bulletin board paper, card stock, construction paper, resume paper, and <u>related items</u>.

While it primarily supports the School of Education, the



Curriculum Library is open and available to everyone and provides comfortable adult and kidfriendly seating. With a lactation pod for nursing mothers close by, the Curriculum Library can be a great spot for students who are also parents to study while their children enjoy a book, a great place to tutor children, or a convenient resource for faculty and staff to bring their own children for age-appropriate materials. Please note that children using the Curriculum Library must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
