<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wore a crown of gold (Ex. 28:36-38; Lev. 8:9) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will wear many crowns of gold (Rev. 14:14; 19:12)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Witnessed the glory of God on a mountain (Ex. 24:9-11) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Demonstrated the glory of God on a mountain (Matt. 17:1-2)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Made an annual atonement for his people (Ex. 30:10) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Made a once-for-all atonement for His people (Heb. 7:27; 10:12, 14)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sprinkled animal blood in the tabernacle of Moses (Lev. 1:5-11) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sprinkled His own blood in the tabernacle of heaven (Heb. 8:2; 9:12-14, 24)
