Liberty University Chancellor Jerry Falwell Jr. announced today that the college is considering selling The Plaza shopping center near downtown Lynchburg to a "reputable developer." The 42-acre site was donated to the school in September 2007 by the Arizona-based Sandor Development Co. At that time, it was assessed at \$11.7 million.
