Aside from playing the nation's top collegiate hockey clubs, [Liberty men's hockey](#) encounters a unique test this Friday at 8 p.m. as the team hosts the Richmond Renegades. A pro team from the Southern Professional Hockey League, the Renegades are visiting the Hill City for the first time in franchise history.

After eight contests this season, Liberty is ranked No. 5 in the American Collegiate Hockey Association with a 7-1 record. In their last outing on Oct. 5, the Flames skated to a solid performance, defeating the Stony Brook Seawolves, 6-3.

Friday's match-up marks Liberty's inaugural meeting with a professional hockey team. Coach Kirk Handy is pleased with his team's performance thus far and is looking forward to the unprecedented contest.
