Standing tall at 4-0, Liberty's football team heads to Conway, S.C., Saturday to take on Big South Conference rival Coastal Carolina University.

Last season, Liberty bested the Chanticleers 37-24 at Williams Stadium as running back Rashad Jennings rushed for 172 yards and three touchdowns.

Head coach Danny Rocco told the media earlier this week he is looking forward to the match-up and expects a great turnout from Flames fans.
