36. **What is the difference between General and Special Revelation?**

- A. In General Revelation God communicates indirectly, as it were behind the stages of human affairs. General Revelation deals primarily with God's power and glory. It is unwritten revelation.
- B. In Special Revelation God communicates directly, as it were on the stage of human affairs. Special Revelation deals primarily with God's person and grace. It is written revelation.
