# Students catch "RecycleMania"

In the first week of the RecycleMania 2008 campaign, Liberty University collected roughly 5 tons of paper and cardboard, equaling about half a pound per person on campus.

Liberty entered the contest along with 372 other colleges nationwide with the purpose of establishing a campus-wide recycling program and carrying forward the biblical concept of good stewardship.

The seven new dorm collection sites have received a steady flow of materials including corrugated cardboard, white and mixed paper since the end of January.

Main Campus residents far exceeded East Campus residents' collections and the dorm collection site with the most recyclables was at the back of the circle near the quads.

The campaign will continue through April 5.
