<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adam introduced sin and death into the world because he disobeyed God. This he passed on to all his descendants. (Rom. 5:12-14; 1 Cor. 15:22a)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Christ introduced righteousness and life into the world because He obeyed God. This He passes on to all who believe in him. (Rom. 5:15-19; 1 Cor. 15:22b)</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>His sin brought a curse upon all nature (Gen. 3:18; Rom. 8:20)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>His sacrifice will eventually eliminate that curse (Gal. 3:13; Rev. 22:3)</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>His sin prevented access to the tree of life in the original paradise (Gen. 3:22-24)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>His sacrifice will permit access to the tree of life in the eternal paradise (Rev. 22:2)</li> </ul>
