### **SIMON PETER**

Event	Reference
Brother of Andrew and fishing partner with James and John	Lk.5:10
A married man	Mk. 1:30; 1 Cor. 9:5
Brought to Christ by his brother Andrew	Jn. 1:41-42
Later called into full-time service by Christ	Lk.5:3-11
Watches Christ heal his mother-in-law	Mt. 8:14-15
Becomes (along with James and John) one of the "Key Three"	Lk.8:51; Mt. 17:1-4; Mt. 26:36-40
Walks on water	Mt. 14:28-31
Gives two great confessions concerning Christ's deity	Jn. 6:68, 69; Mt. 16:16
Allows Satan to influence him concerning Christ's death	Mt. 16:21-23
Catches a fish with a coin in its mouth	Mt. 17:27
Is instructed by Christ concerning forgiveness	Mt. 18:21-22
Sees the transfiguration of Christ	Mt. 17:1-4
Is promised a reward for following Christ	Mt. 19:27
Helps prepare for the final Passover	Lk.22:8
Is present with Christ in the Upper Room	Jn. 13:6, 24, 36
Cuts off Malchus' ear in Gethsemane	Jn. 18:10-11
Follows Christ afar off	Mk. 14:50, 54
Denies Christ on 3 occasions	Jn. 18:15-18, 25-27
Bitterly regrets these denials	Lk.22:62
Visits the empty tomb with John	Lk.24:12; Jn. 20:2-10
Is himself visited by the resurrected Christ	Lk.24:34; 1 Cor. 15:5
Is present at Christ's last miracle by the Galilean Sea	Jn. 21:1-23

### **ANDREW**

Event	Reference
The brother of Peter and a fisherman from Bethsaida in Galilee	Jn. 1:44
An early disciple of John the Baptist	Jn. 1:40
Accepted Christ and brought his brother to the Saviour	Jn. 1:40
Was tested by Christ during the feeding of the 5,000	Jn. 6:12-22
