THE TWELVE APOSTLES OF JESUS (Pt. 2)

JOHN

Event	Reference
A fisherman and brother of James	Mt. 4:21
Was the most prominent Apostle, and a member of the "Key Three"	Mt. 17:1-4
Was an original disciple of John the Baptist	Jn. 1:35
Was gently rebuked by Christ for his sectarianism on one occasion	Lk.9:49-50
Asked Christ for a special place of honor in the millennium	Mk. 10:35
Demonstrated vindictiveness on one occasion	Lk.9:54
Helped prepare for the Last Supper	Lk.22:8
Leaned on the bosom of Christ during the Last Supper	Jn. 13:23
With Peter, he followed Christ afar off	Jn. 18:26
Was the only Apostle present at the cross	Jn. 19:26
Assumed the responsibility of taking care of Mary	Jn. 19:27
Visited the empty tomb along with Peter	Jn. 20:2, 3
Was present during the last miracle of Christ	Jn. 21:7, 23

JAMES

Event	Reference
Brother of John, and fishing partners with Peter and Andrew	Mt. 4:21
Was nicknamed "A Son of Thunder" by Christ	Mk. 3:17
Was the first Apostle to be martyred	Acts 12:1-2

PHILIP

Event	Reference
Brought Nathanael to Christ	Jn. 1:40-46
Had his faith tested during the feeding of the 5,000	Jn. 6:5-7
Was approached by some Greeks who desired to see Jesus	Jn. 12:20-22
Asked Christ to show him the Father	Jn. 14:8-9
