THE SAVIOR WITH KEY INDIVIDUALS (Pt. 2)

THE SAMARITAN WOMAN (John 4:1-42)

1 - The Savior At Sychar (4:1-6)

2 - The Sinner From Sychar (4:7-27)

Jesus Leaves Judea For Galilee

- Why he leaves (4:1-3): He departs to avoid a popularity contest between himself and John.
- Where he stops (4:4-6): He rests beside Jacob's well at Sychar, a town in Samaria.

A Samaritan Woman Comes To The Well For Water

- Jesus' request (4:7-8): He asks her for a drink
- Her response (4:9): She wants to know why he, a Jew, is even talking to her, a Samaritan

The Contrasts:

The Contact:

- Jesus contrasts liquid water with living water

 13 Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever
 drinketh of this water shall thirst again: 14 But
 whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give
 him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall
 give him shall be in him a well of water springing
 up into everlasting life. (Jn. 4:13-14)
- Jesus contrasts ritual worship with real worship

 ²³But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true
 worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and
 in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship
 him. ²⁴God is a Spirit: and they that worship him
 must worship him in spirit and in truth.

 (Jn. 4:23-24).

3 - The Soul Winner In Sychar

Note The Faithfulness And Fruitfulness Of The Samaritan Woman

- Her Faithfulness
 - ²⁵The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. ²⁶Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he. ²⁸The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, ²⁹Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? ([n. 4:25-26,28-29)
- Her Fruitfulness
 - ³⁹And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did. (Jn. 4:39)
