## **Events During The Lord's Supper**

## 1. THE PATTERN

• Jesus Holds Up The Bread Representing His Body:

<sup>26</sup>And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. <sup>27</sup>And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it. (Mt. 26:26-27)

## 2. THE PREDICTION

Jesus Holds Up The Cup, Representing His Blood:

<sup>28</sup>For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. (Mt. 26:28)

## He Said All Would Desert Him:

<sup>31</sup>Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad. <sup>32</sup>But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee. (Mt. 26:31-32)

## Jesus Assures His Disciples

<sup>1</sup>Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. <sup>2</sup>In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup>And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. <sup>27</sup>Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (Jn. 14:1-3, 27).

## He Said One Would Deny Him:

<sup>33</sup>Peter answered and said unto him, Though all men shall be offended because of thee, yet will I never be offended. <sup>34</sup>Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. <sup>35</sup>Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. Likewise also said all the disciples. (Mt. 26:33-35)

## Jesus Answers His Disciples

- Q) **Thomas:** "How can we know the way?"
- A) **Jesus:** <sup>6</sup>Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. (Jn. 14:6)
- Q) **Philip:** "Show us the Father."
- A) **Jesus:** "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father."
- Q) **Judas (not Iscariot):** "<sup>22</sup> Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?" (Jn. 14:22)
- A) **Jesus:** "<sup>23</sup>Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him." (Jn. 14:23)
