## DENIALS BY PETER, THE DEATH OF JUDAS

### FRIDAY: PETER'S DENIALS

#### 1 - The Setting Involved

<sup>54</sup>But Peter followed Him at a distance, right into the courtyard of the high priest. And he sat with the servants and warmed himself at the fire. (Mk. 14:54)

#### 2 - The Sin Involved

- **First Denial:**

<sup>66</sup>Now as Peter was below in the courtyard, one of the servant girls of the high priest came. <sup>67</sup>And when she saw Peter warming himself, she looked at him and said, "You also were with Jesus of Nazareth." <sup>68</sup>But he denied it, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are saying." And he went out on the porch, and a rooster crowed. (Mk. 14:66-68)

- **Second Denial:**

<sup>71</sup>And when he had gone out to the gateway, another girl saw him and said to those who were there, "This fellow also was with Jesus of Nazareth." <sup>72</sup>But again he denied with an oath, "I do not know the Man!" (Mt. 26:71, 72)

- **Third Denial:**

<sup>59</sup>Then after about an hour had passed, another confidently affirmed, saying, "Surely this fellow also was with Him, for he is a Galilean." (Lk.22:59) <sup>71</sup>Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know this Man of whom you speak!" (Mk. 14:71)

#### 3 - The Sound Involved

Immediately a rooster crowed (Mt. 26:74b).

#### 4 - The Sorrow Involved

<sup>61</sup>And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had said to him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." <sup>62</sup>So Peter went out and wept bitterly. (Lk. 22:61-62)

### FRIDAY: JUDAS' DEATH

#### 1 - The Bloody Silver

- **The Despair of Judas:**

<sup>3</sup>Then Judas, His betrayer, seeing that He had been condemned, was remorseful and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, <sup>4</sup>saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." And they said, "What is that to us? You see to it!" (Mt. 27:3-4)

- **The Death of Judas:**

<sup>5</sup>Then he threw down the pieces of silver in the temple and departed, and went and hanged himself (Mt. 27:5).

#### 2 - The Bloody Soil

##### The Deliberation By The Priests

<sup>6</sup>But the chief priests took the silver pieces and said, "It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because they are the price of blood" (Mt. 27:6).

##### The Decision By The Priests

- **The Property They Found:**

<sup>7</sup>And they consulted together and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. <sup>8</sup>Therefore that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day. (Mt. 27:7-8)

- **The Prophecy They Fulfilled:**

<sup>9</sup>Then was fulfilled what was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, saying, "And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the value of Him who was priced, whom they of the children of Israel priced, <sup>10</sup>and gave them for the potter's field, as the LORD directed me". (Mt. 27:9-10)
