9 - The Contempt For The Cross

● By The Thieves:

⁴⁴Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing. (Mt. 27:44)

● By The Passing Crowd:

³⁹And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads ⁴⁰and saying, You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross. (Mt. 27:39-40)

● By The Jewish Rulers:

⁴Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the scribes and elders, said, ⁴²"He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. ⁴³"He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God'. (Mt. 27:41-43)

● By The Soldiers:

³⁶The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine, ³⁷and saying, "If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself". (Lk.23:36-37)

10 - The Cries From The Cross

During The Six Hour Ordeal On The Cross Jesus Uttered Seven Statements

The FIRST 3 Hours: 9:00AM - Noon

1

Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do. (Lk. 23:34)

2

Verily I say unto thee, today thou shalt be with me in paradise. (Lk. 23:43)

3

Woman, behold thy son! Behold thy mother. (Jn. 19:26, 27)

The FINAL 3 Hours: Noon - 3:00PM

4

My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken me? (Mt. 27:46)

5

I thirst. (Jn. 19:28)

6

It is finished. (Jn. 19:30)

7

Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit. (Lk. 23:46)

11 - The Confusion About The Cross

⁴⁷Some of those who stood there, when they heard that, said, "This Man is calling for Elijah!" ⁴⁸Immediately one of them ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine and put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink. ⁴⁹The rest said, "Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to save Him" (Mt. 27:47-49).

12 - The Final Cup At The Cross

²⁹Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth. ³⁰So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit (Jn. 19:29-30).
