ISIS' Religious Foundations

- Jama'at al-Tawhid wa'al-Jihad (JTJ) and Al Qaeda in Iraq
- Zarqawi, Salafi-jihadists, and the Qur'an
 - Historical outlook: Emulate the first Muslims
 - Early AQI goals
 - Shari'a Law- strict but subjective

ISIS' Religious Foundations Continued

- Slavery
 - Based on history and the Qur'an
 - Slavery is a gift from God
 - Qur'anic verses on marital subjugation (Sura 56; 66)
 - Qur'an's approval of rape (Sura 2)
 - Form of worship
 - Subhuman position of slave women
- Disagreements with the Yazidi Religion
 - Peacock God

- Importance of the Caliphate implies new members
 - New members need incentive: slaves
 - Online and in-person slave auctions
- Virgins
 - "symbol of honor, power and land"
 - Heavenly reward (Sura 56)
 - Immediacy of sexual access

 - Assisting in Rape
 - ISIS woman handcuffed Turko daily
